**Re: California Proposition 65 – Statement of Conformity**

Matalco designates that, to the best of our knowledge, our Aluminum, Aluminum Remelt alloys and Aluminum wrought alloys we produce, are California Proposition 65 (formerly known as the Safe Drinking Water & Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986) compliant as of the date listed.

The Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA), which is part of the California Environmental Protection Agency (Cal/EPA), administers the Proposition 65 program and imposes certain requirements on persons/businesses doing business in California that has products containing specific listed chemicals, which can be found at [The Proposition 65 List - OEHHA](#)

Some of the California Proposition 65 substances such as Lead (Pb), Cadmium (Cd) and Mercury (Hg) can be present in our foundry alloys. Based on Pb and Cd measurements done by Optical Emission Spectrography (OES) and Hg measurements obtained by Glow Discharge-Mass Spectrometry method, we confirm levels as follows:
